### Altering of names.

In my paper „Help-notes towards the determination and classification of the European Myrmeleonidae“ (Entom. Medd., København, p. 97—127, 1918) I proposed the name *Archæmyrmeleonidae* for the Palparid-like forms, and the name *Neomyrmeleonidae* for the rest of *Myrmeleonidae*. It was not my intention to divide the natural family into two, and therefore I propose to alter the name *Archæmyrmeleonidae* into *Archæmyrmeleonida* and *Neomyrmeleonidae* into *Neomyrmeleonida*. The first named division includes only one subfamily, the *Palparinae*, while the second includes two, the *Dendroleoninae* and the *Myrmeleonidae*.
