- Is an international open data infrastructure, funded by governments.
- Provides a single point of access to hundreds of millions of biodiversity data records, shared freely by hundreds of institutions worldwide, making it the biggest biodiversity database on the Internet.
- Operates through a network of nodes, coordinating the biodiversity information facilities of participant countries and organisations.

Biodiversity is the variety of life found on Earth, i.e. the entirety of genes, species and ecosystems.

Occurrence data: where, when and by whom is a species observed or collected.
